



Technical Regulations for Private Clubs For Aikido









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# A/ Technical Requirements





#### **1. Coaches**

1.1 The skills and experience that the Trainer must have, according to the standards of the Saudi Aikido Committee, provided that the certificates and experiences required here are reviewed by the committee, as follows:

- The Coaches must be no less than a 3rd Dan Aikikai black belt.
- - He received a training course from the Training and Development Department of the Saudi Aikido Committee.
- - He is accredited and licensed by the Saudi Aikido Committee.



#### 2. Facilities

- **2.1** Formation of the administrative staff that must be available in each facility.
- 2.2 \*Receptionist (administrative for men).
  - \*Receptionist (administrative for women).
  - \*Coach for men and coach for women.

**2.3** The presence of a first aid certificate for the coach or any of the administrative staff. Proof of ownership or lease of the facility on which the project will be built.

- **2.4** Specifications of facilities that must be provided in establishments:
  - \*The floor must be level and suitable for installing the mat.
  - \* There must be a safety perimeter of 1.5m 2m around the mat.

\* If there is more than one sport: provide a space-free mat with a minimum thickness of 5 cm, with dimensions of 10 m \* 10 m, and it must be inside a room free of columns and barriers.

#### 3. Equipment

**3.1** Provide a mirror on one of the walls opposite the mat, **2** meters high and above the ground.

**Clothing :-**

Aikido: Commitment to wearing aikido clothing (white suit) pants + jacket + belt + black hakama for black belt holders during training and competitions.



#### 4. Safety

- **4.1** Upon acceptance of the player, the player is required to submit a medical examination stating that the participant is medically fit and the club is held the full responsibility for that.

- 4.2 Having a certified physiotherapist for the team or a valid contract with a clinic from the Saudi Federation for Health Specialties. In the event that a specialist is available but not accredited, one can apply for accreditation by filling out the following form by the Saudi Federation for Sports Medicine (SFSM) http://sfsm.org.sa/mos30

- 4.3 First Aid Provide first aid kit with adequate equipment as it's stipulated here http://sfsm.org.sa/mos70 as per SFSM's minimum standards, and to have an ambulance car during games & tournaments (if available).

- ✓ Small Bag: SAR 12,650 (up to 50 persons)
- ✓ Large bag: SAR 14,375 (up to 100 persons)
- 4.4 Fire alarm system according to the requirements of the Civil Defense



#### 5. Competition

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**5.1** The Saudi Arabian Olympic Committee and Federations issues the conditions and instructions regulating the internal and external participations, whether in training camps, tournaments or competitions, and circulates them to the sports federations to work in accordance with them.



# **B/ Administrative Requirements**





#### 6. Membership

6.1 .7Membership1.6 To obtain membership in the committee, the entity wishing to join must submit an application to the committee, and the executive management reviews the application and ensures its completion before submitting it to the Board of Directors, no later than thirty days, and the following is attached to it:

6.1-1 A statement of the names, qualifications and experiences of technicians and supervisors of the activity and game.

- **6.1-2** -A statement that includes existing facilities, stadiums and equipment.
- 6.1-3 -Declaring compliance with the regulations, decisions and regulations issued by the committee.
- **6.1-4** -Receipt of payment of the prescribed fee for membership in the committee.
- **6.1-5** -Any requirements that the committee deems necessary.

6.2 The Board of Directors will study the application and issue its decision within thirty days. From the date the request is submitted by the committee's executive management.

6.3 The applicant shall be notified of the Board of Directors' decision within fifteen days from the date of approval to the address recorded in the application for admission, and the Olympic Committee shall be provided with a copy of the decision. The membership applicant is considered a member of the committee from the date of issuance of the Board of Directors' decision.

6.4 If the application is rejected by the Board of Directors, the decision must be reasoned, and the membership applicant has the right to appeal the decision to the Olympic Committee within fifteen days from the date of being informed of the decision, and the decision will be final.

6.5 If the membership applicant is not notified of the Board of Directors' decision within the period referred to in the previous paragraphs, he has the right to raise the matter to the Olympic Committee.

6.6 Aikido: The player must be at least 7 years old. (membership is renewed annually after obtaining the technical opinion from the committee)

7. Fees

#### 7. Fees

7.1 Annual membership fees are as follows:

Aikido: The financial deposit for the applicant for a new and existing license is free of charge for the first year, then it is renewed annually (1,500) one thousand five hundred Saudi riyals.



#### 8. Violations & Penalties

8.1 In the event that the Federation's terms and instructions are not implemented, the following penalties will apply :

8.1-1 The academy receives a warning to avoid repeating the violation .

8.1-2 In the case of a repeat violation, a fine of (2,500) Saudi riyals will be imposed.

8.1-3 If the violation is repeated for the third time, a period of one week is given for correction. If the correction is not made within a week, the Federation suspends the game license and prevents anyone from practicing for a month. It will be reopened after correction and payment of the fine tripled in the table below after signing a pledge and then canceling membership in the game federation.

1	Not adhering to Instructor Standards	2500 SR
2	Not adhering to Safety Standards	2500 SR
3	Not Wearing proper Exercise Clothing	2500 SR
