A/ Technical Requirements







1. Coaches

- **1.1 First criterion :** Has a university degree, preferably in sports.
- **1.2 Second criterion:** Got a training certificate from the International Table-Soccer Federation (First level).
- **1.3 Third criterion:** Got a national training certificates.
- **1.4 Forth criterion:** Has at least three years of experience in training clubs.





2. Facilities

- **2.1 First criterion:** The area of the hall for practicing the game in the club must not be less than (20mx10m).
- **2.2 Second criterion:** Consideration the lighting and ceiling height of the hall (hall height: not less than 5m lighting: 600 lighting units).
- 2.3 Third criterion: The space can accommodate at least 4 Table-Soccer.
- 2.4 Forth criterion: Having enough exits for emergencies.
- **2.5 Fifth criterion**: Existence enough numbers of restrooms for each category.





3. Equipment

3.1First criterion: The equipment must be from approved brands by the International Table-Soccer Federation (Tornado - Roberto Sport - Bonzini - Leonhart - Garlando).

3.2 Second criterion: The floor of the hall must be legal to avoid injuries to players.

3.3 Third criterion: The playing balls must be approved by the International Table-Soccer Federation.





4. Safety

4.1 Upon acceptance of the player, the player is required to submit a medical examination stating that the participant is medically fit and the academy is held the full responsibility for that.

To obtain this form, the player must complete the form from the Saudi Sports Medicine Federation.

Then, the hospital/clinic must complete the form from the Saudi Sports Medicine Federation.

4.2 Having a certified physiotherapist for the team or a valid contract with a clinic from the Saudi Federation for Health Specialties. In the event that a specialist is available but not accredited, one can apply for accreditation by filling out the following form by the Saudi Federation for Sports Medicine (SFSM).

** If needed, SFSM provides a list of physiotherapists.

4.3 First Aid - Provide first aid kit with adequate equipment, as per SFSM's minimum standards, and to have an ambulance car during games & tournaments.

4.4 Fire alarm system according to the requirements of the Civil Defense





5. Competition

5.1 The Saudi Arabian Olympic and Paralympic Committee and the federations issue the requirements and instructions regulating internal and external participation, whether in camps, tournaments, or competitions, and circulate them to the sports federations to implement them.

5.2 Federations may set conditions for participation in the competition, with some individual games being exempted, at the Federation's estimate and in accordance with the Federation's policy.

5.3 All clubs are entitled to participate in Table-Soccer activities, starting with the Ministry's office competitions in the regions and governorates.

5.4 Qualified clubs from the regions are entitled to participate in the Kingdom's Table-Soccer championships, according to the regulations of the Ministry of Sports.

6. Membership

6.1 Membership and its requirements. (Any officially registered Table-Soccer club is considered a member of the Saudi Table-Soccer Federation.)





7. Fees

7.1 The Saudi table-soccer federation charges an annual fee of SR 4,000.

7. Fees

7.2 Required fees (subject to the rules and regulations of the Ministry of Sports) if there are any instructions.





8. Violations & Penalties

8.1 If clubs do not pay the annual fee, their membership in the Federation will be revoked and they will not be allowed to participate in any Federation or game activities or hold any events related to the game.

8.2 If clubs violate their commitment to the goals they established, the Federation has the right to contact the Ministry of Sports to close the academy.

8.3 Below are the penalties and fines imposed on clubs if any violations:
