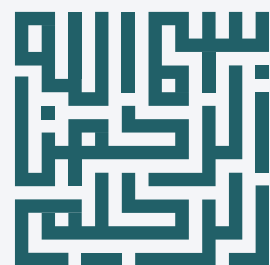




## Table Tennis Technical Regulations for Private Clubs

## A/ Technical Requirements



## 1. Coaches

The first criterion is to have a university degree, preferably in the field of sports

1.2 The second criterion: Obtaining a training certificate from the International Table Tennis Federation LEVEL 1

1.3 Third standard: Obtaining national training certificates

1.4 The fourth criterion is that he must have coaching experience in clubs of no less than 5 years

## 2. Facilities

2.1 The first standard: A legal area for the gym to practice the game in the club is not less than (20m x 10m)

2.2 The second criterion: Taking into account lighting and the height of the hall ceiling (hall height: not less than 5 m - lighting: 600 lighting units)

3.2 Third criterion: The space can accommodate a minimum of 4 tennis tables

4.2 Fourth criterion: The presence of a sufficient number of exits for emergency situations

5.2 Fifth standard: There is a sufficient number of toilets allocated for each category

## 3. Equipment

3.1 The first criterion: The tools must be of brands approved by the International Table Tennis Federation (Tabhar - Donk - Betterfly - Stiga - Goola)

3.2 The second criterion: The hall floor must be legal to avoid injuries to the players

3.3 The third criterion: The player's equipment, including rackets and leathers, must be of brands approved by the International Table Tennis Federation (Tabahar - Donk - Betterfly - Stiga - Gola)



## 4. Safety

- 4.1** Upon acceptance of the player, the player is required to submit a medical examination stating that the participant is medically fit and the club is held the full responsibility for that.

- 4.2** Having a certified physiotherapist for the team or a valid contract with a clinic from the Saudi Federation for Health Specialties. In the event that a specialist is available but not accredited, one can apply for accreditation by filling out the following form by the Saudi Federation for Sports Medicine (SFSM) <http://sfsm.org.sa/mos30>
- \*\*** If needed, SFSM provides a list of physiotherapists. To request, please click on: <http://sfsm.org.sa/mos40>
- 4.3 First Aid** - Provide first aid kit with adequate equipment as it's stipulated here <http://sfsm.org.sa/mos70> as per SFSM's minimum standards, and to have an ambulance car during games & tournaments (if available).

- ✓ **Small Bag:** SAR 12,650 (up to 50 persons)
  - ✓ **Large bag:** SAR 14,375 (up to 100 persons)
- 4.4 Fire alarm system according to the requirements of the Civil Defense**

## 5. Competition

5.1 The Saudi Arabian Olympic Committee and the federations issue the requirements and instructions regulating internal and external participation, whether in camps. Or tournaments or competitions and circulate them to sports federations to act accordingly

5.2 Federations can set requirements for joining the competition, excluding some individual games according to the federation's discretion based on the federations mechanism.

5.3 All clubs have the right to participate in table tennis activities, starting with competitions for the Ministry's offices in the regions and governorates

5.4 The qualified clubs from the regions have the right to participate in the Kingdom's table tennis championships according to the regulations of the Ministry of Sports

## 6. Membership

6.1 Membership and requirements. (Any club officially registered to play table tennis is considered a member of the Saudi Table Tennis Federation)

## 7. Fees

7.1 Required fees (subject to the rules and regulations of the Ministry of Sports) in the event of any directives

7.2 The Saudi Table Tennis Federation receives an annual fee of 4,000 riyals
